Introduction :

The SOLACE, NGO, Nagaon, Assam is a Non-Political, Non-Communal National Level Voluntary Organization of Nagaon duly registered under societies registration Act. XXI of 1860, vide Regd. No. - RS/NG/254/G/112 of 2006 Dtd. 12-12-2006. It was established in the year 2005 and since then it has been conducting a lot of Social Development activities from its sources, with the co-operation of community people for the all round development of the down trodden, backward sections as well as women, children and older sections of the society.

Executive Committee:

The SOLACE, NGO, Nagaon, Assam has a strong Executive Committee duly constituted with Nine Nos. of members represented from youth section and various communities around the State. The committee normally instituted its regular meetings to resolve various decisions as per need and look after its development activities undertaken. This committee is headed by Sri Arup Bordoloi, President and Sri Imtiazur Rahman Hazarika as General Secretary respectively.

The SOLACE, NGO, Nagaon, Assam has been achieving a number of Social Development activities during the year with the help and co-operation of Govt. Agencies and its own sources under the help and co-operation of the Community people among society. A details break up of the development activities undertaken by the organization are elaborated below.

1. Skill Development Training:

The SOLACE, NGO, Nagaon (Assam) has been conducted a skill development programme at Puranigudam, Nagaon to Provide necessary training to the local artisans 85 nos. of local poor women enrolled in this programme and they are given weaving and other commercial training like cutting, tailoring, cutting and embroidery and food processing by the experts engaged from the source of the organization. Technical experts to run this programme are provided by the District Handloom & Textiles Authority, DICC and Agriculture Deptt. of Nagaon. After having training women are practiced how to produce weaving and other commodities and the productive articles are sold in local markets women are given lump sump incentives from the sale proceeds of the programme.

2. Youth and Adolescent Development Programme:

A Youth Development Programme is conducted by the organization to improve the skill of the Youths in its jurisdiction various training are organized by the organization. So that the Youth may choose this career for their brighter livelihood. Sports activity also organized among the Youths and also show them path how to conduct their legal life among the community and also aware them on drug abuse etc.

3. Welfare to the Street Children:

The organization undertaken a Welfare Programme for the development of Street Children in the District of Nagaon. More than 175 no's of Street Children are registered by the organization and they are given a number of skill development training to sustained their establishment.

4. Preservation of Manuscript and Rare Books :

The organization conducted awareness programme in its jurisdiction during the year on preservation of Manuscripts/Rare books among community which are feel essential now a days. Seminar and group meetings are organized among community and they are encourage to the responsibility for keeping the Manuscripts carefully. This programme is conducted from organization sources.

5. Celebrations:

The organization observed various National, International and Special days and Divash during the year like the nation of observed from time to time. These are like Independence Day, Republic Day, New Year Day, Silpi Divash, Rabha Divash, Gandhi Jayanti, International Literacy Day, International Women Day, World Environment Day, World Aids Day, World Population Day, Labour Day, Bana

Mahantsava, Koumi Ekta Saptah etc. During these observation the organization organized various speech, Art and Quiz Competition etc. among students and provided award to the development of their traditional cottage industries. More than 500 nos. of local artisans are covered by this programme conducted.

6. Welfare to the Disabled Persons:

The organization undertaken a welfare programme for the development of Disable person in the District of Nagaon and Kamrup (M). More than 250 nos. of disabled person are registered by the organization and they are given a number of skill development training to sustained their establishment.
